• Theme 1: Mobilization of Regions

Key findings from research on regional mobilization in the EU will be highlighted. What determines the organizational form of regional representation in Brussels? What explains varying levels of regional mobilization? Which policy issues are important for regional representatives? And which advocacy tactics and networks do regional representations adopt when seeking to influence EU policies?
