Mental health in figures


- ❖ 1 in 6 people suffered from mental health issues before the COVID-19 pandemic
- Suicide is the second leading cause of death among young people aged 15-19
- ❖ Annual value of lost mental health in children and young people is estimated at €50 billion

Guiding principles

- Access to adequate and effective prevention

The comprehensive approach:

- Calls upon national and regional actors, health and non-health policy sectors, and relevant stakeholders to work together.
- ✓ Aims to put tools in place to drive change
- ✓ Supports Member States in their efforts to achieve the WHO targets for NCDs by 2025 and SDG by 2030





Integrating mental health across policies

1. European Mental Health Capacity Building Initiative

- ✓ WHO and Commission: support to Member States to build capacity for a mental health across policies approach (€11 million)
- ✓ Projects implemented by stakeholders vulnerable groups, migrants/refugees, children... (€10 million)

- ✓ EU4Health 2023 work programme: projects on providing psychological support to cancer patients, their carers and families. (€8 million)
