# From local to cross-border activism for Europe





- November 2016: first demonstrations in Frankfurt
- January 2017: weekly demonstrations start
- March 2017: set-up PoE coordination office
- April 2017: 100 cities in 14 countries
- November 2017: almost 140 cities in 21 countries

# Engaging citizens on the streets and online





#### On the streets:

- demonstrations and stage programme (Sunday, 14:00)
- shared Europe-wide actions and campaigns (European civil society)
- (social) media coverage as an amplifier of bottom-up activism

#### Platform:

- to enable citizens to become active (Europe activism)
- to engage with Europe and opinion building
- to strengthen European civil society (build a relationship with Europe and other European citizens)

# Building an emotional relationship



- actions and campaigns, when and where they are needed (on the streets)
- enable citizens to become active: fun and low barrier to join



- positive communication, clear messages and calls for action
- emotions: reaching the hearts of citizens, not only their intellect (make the pulse felt)
- visible and audible (coverage)
- stories worth sharing (media and online)
- creation of an experience: emotions go viral
- social media and use of #hashtags

- #OurEuropeNow: Open letter to the German party leaders to take Europe into account (during coalition agreement negotiations) (November 2017)
- #OurEuropeNow: Flash mob singing *Ode an die Freude* as a symbolic move in support of Macron's engagement with Europe (September 2017)
- #PulseforPoland: Vigil in front of Polish consulates and embassies in support for PoE Warsaw (July 2017)
