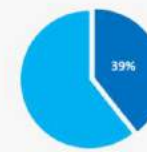
Share of GDP



Share of the State's revenues

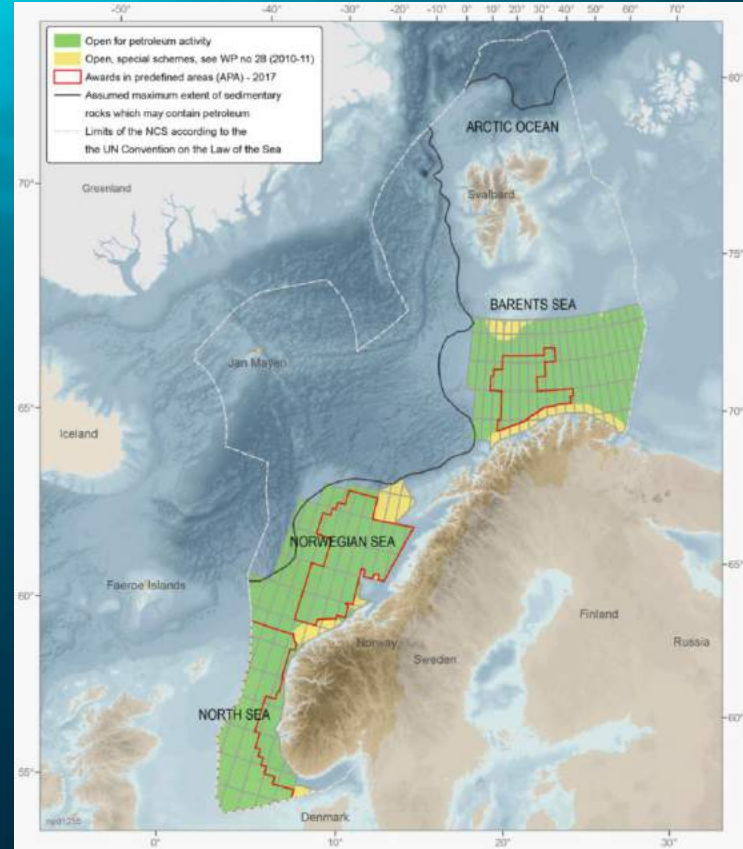
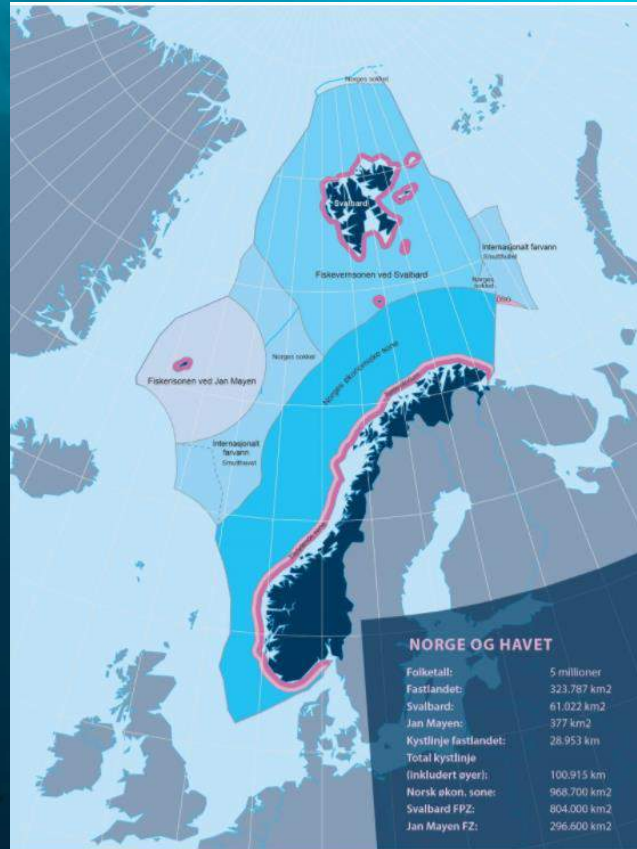


Share of total investments

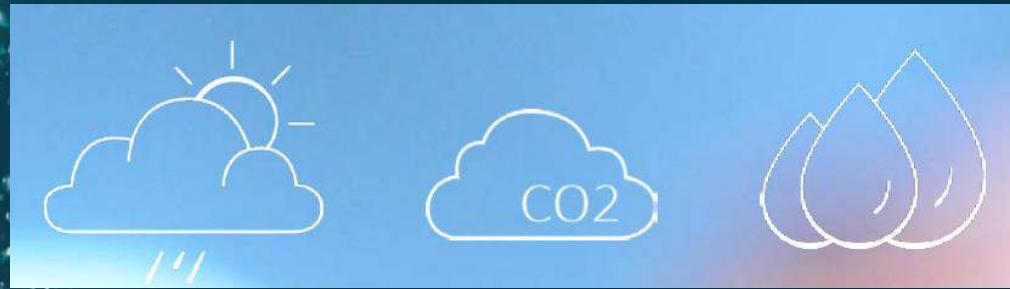
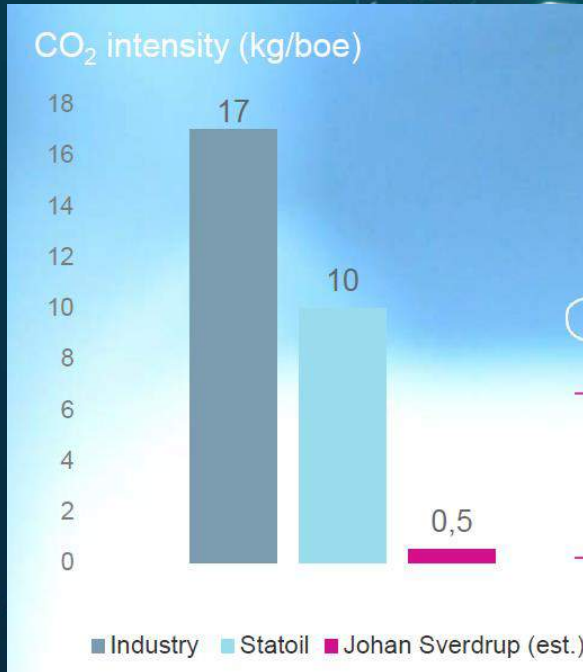

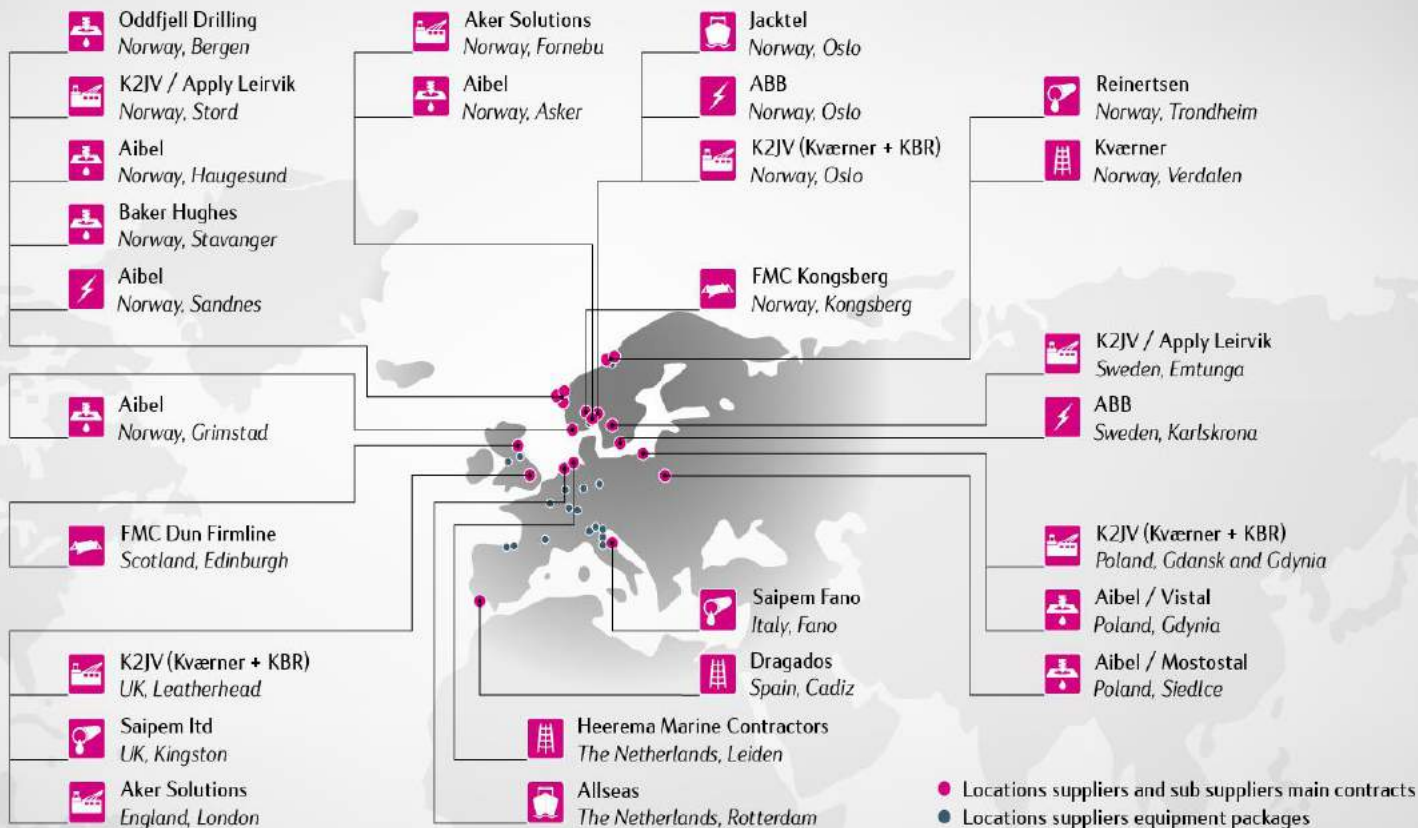
