Objective of the Strategy

- A better protection of citizens' health and preservation of the environment.
- Supporting innovation in the field of safe and sustainable chemicals, thereby stimulating economy and increasing its competitiveness on the global market.

Main topics – issues (1 of 3)

- Promoting interregional cooperation along sustainable value chains in chemicals through smart specialisation in order to accelerate the development of joint investments projects.
- Upgrading employees qualifications for the purposes of digital and green transformation.

Main topics – issues (2 of 3)

- Adopting or reinforcing provisions in order to include combined chemicals impact on water, food contact materials, food additives, toys, detergents, cosmetics.
- Fund on European Union-wide monitoring of human and environment control.
- Reinforcing the open, strategic autonomy of the EU, regarding access to critical raw materials.

Main topics – issues (3 of 3)

- Development and implementation of infrastructure that enables to use, transport and storage of electric energy from renewable sources/ sources that are carbon neutral in the production of chemicals.
- Investment in sustainable innovations, being able to disinfect the waste streams, increase safe recycling and to limit the disposal of waste, in particular of plastics and textiles.
